1. “It is difficult to avoid the conclusion that the so called National War of Independence of 1857 was neither First, nor National, nor War of Independence”. Based on this argument given by R.C. Majumdar, critically asses the nature of the revolt of 1857 of 1857.

But grant me this, too, that each time I may give up my life in the service of Motherland.” Based on this patriotic quotes of Ram Prasad Bismil, analyse the influence of Indian cultural past and impact of historical research for the development of Indian nationalism.
